

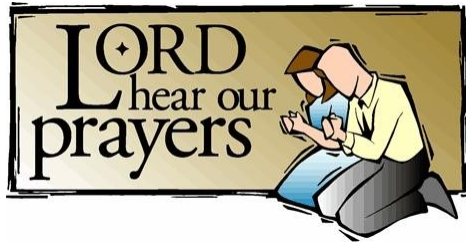

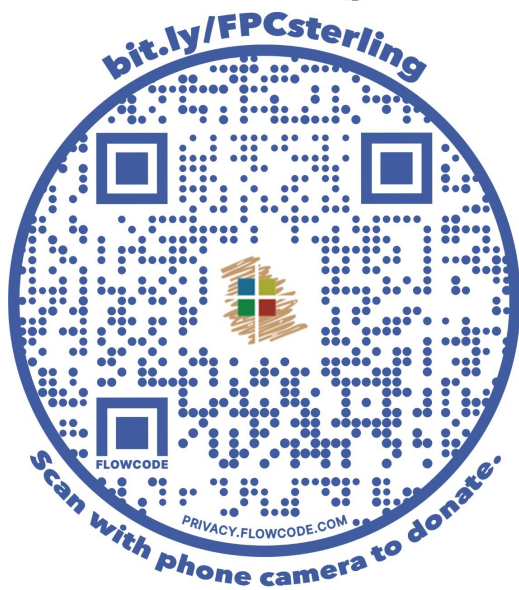

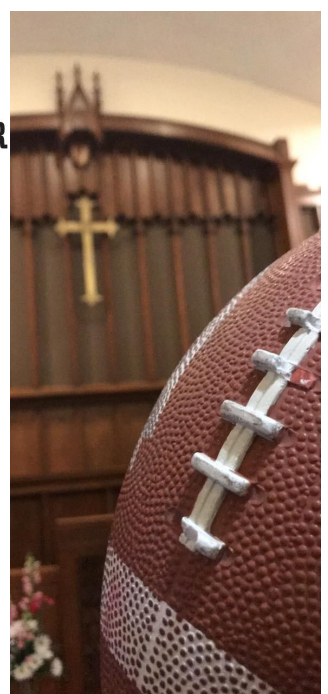

Prayer of Confession

God, we confess to you that we have failed. You created us to be your people, to be united in your Spirit, with Christ as our head: one Lord, one faith, one baptism. But we have decided that we are individuals. We ignore your commandment to love you and love one another, instead demanding that everyone must respect our personal choices. We exploit the gifts you give us to promote our own positions, support our own status, advocate our own agendas. Others of us focus on our individual inadequacies, as if your gospel depends on who we are, so when we could speak for love and justice, we remain silent; and when we could move together as one body, we sit idle. Forgive us! Help us to claim and use our distinct gifts, to provide guidance and accountability for one another, to be faithful followers of Christ, knowing that we are greater as one Body than any single member.
